Chevrolet / Boardman fire engine that was a front-line engine until being rotated out of service in May 2018 due to new equipment purchases. This is a good pumper with low miles.

The fire engine is a C65 series Chevrolet / Boardman, has a 427 c.i. gasoline engine and a 5-speed transmission. The fire engine has a 500-gallon booster tank, a single stage 1000-gpm Waterous pump. The fire engine comes with a full emergency lighting package, 100-watt siren, scene lights, six (6) 10.00 R 20 tires, load range G with low mileage in excellent condition, 2 booster reels, 1 booster reel hose, hose bed cover, commercial wheel chocks, 35-foot extension ladder, 14-foot roof ladder, and two (2) 4" intake Storz valves. New carburetor and gas lines installed in 2016. This truck passed pump test in 2017. Short, maneuverable truck.

The fire engine is a 60 series Chevrolet / Central, has a 327 c.i. gasoline engine, 5 speed transmission and 2 speed rear end. The fire engine has a 500-gallon booster tank, a two stage 750-gpm Waterous pump. The fire engine comes with a full emergency lighting package, 100 watt siren, Icom mobile radio, scene lights, six (6) 9.00 - 20 tires, load range F with low mileage, 2 pieces of hard suction, 2

booster reels with hose on each, 35-foot ladder, 14-foot roof ladder, and a 4" Storz intake valve. This truck passed pump test in 2017.

Information to Vendor:

1. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF ENGAGEMENT

The City of Macon is seeking to acquire a 1-ton Cab & Chassis with snow plow and drop-side dump bed for our Street Department. This unit is to be used for snow removal and various street repair projects. Proposal should include purchase price, equipment features and specifications, warranty options, and service availability.

2. DATE & PLACE FOR RECEIVING PROPOSAL

Proposals will be accepted until **Monday, September 10, 2018 @ 1:00 P.M.** Send proposals to City of Macon, Attention: City Clerk, 106 W. Bourke Street, Macon, Missouri, 63552. Proposals received after the closing date will be returned unopened.

3. SUBMISSION

Proposals may be mailed or hand-delivered. Proposals are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, plainly marked "Snow Plow Truck " on the lower right-hand corner of the envelope face.

4. DISQUALIFICATION OF VENDORS

Any evidence of collusion between Vendors will be sufficient to reject all Proposals so affected.

5. ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF PROPOSAL(S)

The City reserve the right to accept or reject any or all Proposals, and to accept any Proposal considered in its' best interest. The lowest or any Proposal will not necessarily be accepted.

6. CLARIFICATION

It is the Vendor's responsibility to clarify any details in question before submitting a proposal. All bid submission concerns must be directed to City Clerk, Mary Lou Craigg at 660-385-6421. All technical questions should be directed to the Street Department Superintendent, Gerald Piland at 660-385-2632.

7. ERROR AND CORRECTIONS

The City reserves the right in its total discretion to make all necessary corrections to any Proposal which contains clear mathematical calculation errors (e.g. two numbers are added together incorrectly) and may refer to the unit price in making such corrections. In all other cases of error, the City reserves the right to seek clarification from a Vendor and allow the Vendor to provide a corrected response.

8. WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSAL

Vendors will be permitted to withdraw their Proposal unopened after it has been submitted, only if such request is received in writing **prior** to the closing date.

9. DURATION OF OFFER

All proposal responses **must indicate they are valid for a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days** from the date of the proposal closing date unless extended by mutual written agreement between the City and the Vendor.

10. ANNOUNCEMENT

No results will be given until complete report is reviewed and approved by the parties involved. Any communications with respect to the award will be made by the City.

EQUIPMENT FEATURES

Every respondent shall provide their pricing upon the following minimum criteria. Actual specifications may exceed these specifications.

- 1-ton cab & chassis, with Knapheide, 60"CA
- Dually rear axle
- Diesel
- Regular cab
- 4x4
- 6 speed automatic transmission
- Locking differential rear axle
- Work truck package (split bench seat, no carpet)
- Snow plow prep package
- Trailering package
- Tires: all season or winter tread
- 9' snow plow, electric, handheld controls
- 9' drop-side (16"-sides) dump bed, electric controls

In order to fairly evaluate each proposal, specifications for each equipment offered should be precisely detailed.
